Main Functions of CDSCO

Let's break down what CDSCO does to make sure drugs are safe in India:

1. CDSCO Registration in India

Any drug or medical product that is imported or manufactured in India must go through <u>CDSCO registration</u>. This is a legal process that helps the government keep track of which companies are making or importing what kind of drugs or devices.

During this process, CDSCO checks:

- The quality of the product

- Safety data

2. Drug License Registration

3. Medical Device Registration in India

- Certification from authorities like ISO or WHO

Once the product passes all checks, CDSCO gives permission to sell or import it in India.

4. Cosmetic License for Manufacturing

Cosmetic products like face creams, shampoos, deodorants, and powders are also regulated by CDSCO. Even though cosmetics are not used inside the body, they can still cause skin infections, allergies, or long-term harm if they are made with dangerous chemicals.

Before a company starts making cosmetics in India, it needs to apply for a <u>Cosmetic manufacturer License</u> from CDSCO. The agency checks:

- List of ingredients
- Product formula
- Hygiene and cleanliness of the factory
- Packaging and labeling

This way, CDSCO ensures only safe cosmetic products reach consumers.

How CDSCO Helps in Drug Safety

Now that we know what CDSCO does, let's understand how it helps in keeping drugs safe:

✓ Approves Only Safe Medicines

New medicines must go through detailed clinical trials. CDSCO reviews the results before giving permission to sell the medicine in the market.

✓ Inspects Manufacturing Units

CDSCO inspects pharmaceutical factories to check if they are following Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP). If they find any problems, they can stop production.

✓ Tests Drug Samples

Samples are collected from time to time and sent to labs. If a drug fails the quality test, it is banned or recalled.

\checkmark Issues Alerts and Recalls

If a medicine or device causes unexpected side effects, CDSCO can alert the public, stop sales, and recall the product immediately.

✓ Ensures Labeling and Packaging

Important details like dosage, expiry date, ingredients, and storage conditions must be printed on every package. CDSCO checks that these rules are followed.
